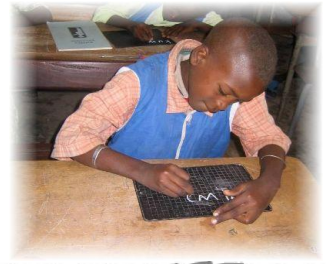


Senegal Literacy Project

Five-Day Schedule



We understand that Children's ministry schedules keep you busy! If you need to spread the three Senegal Literacy Project lessons out over five shorter sessions, this schedule may work for you. Each session is approximately 15 minutes long. They could serve as a supplement to your daily vacation Bible school program.

Day 1

Lesson 1: Where in the World is Senegal?
"Cents to Send" activity (and optional bank cube craft)

Day 2

From Lesson 2: Hello, Senegal

- Review
- Wolof Greeting
- Distribute Fun Pages and read or tell the story "We Were Blind but Now We See."

Day 3

From Lesson 2: Hello, Senegal

- Tonal Languages
- Talking Drums—If allowing the entire group to experiment with a talking drum or with rubber bands is impractical, consider using a small group of children from each class or demonstrating the tone changes yourself.
- What Can You Do Now?

Day 4

From Lesson 3: Living in Senegal

- Scripture Study
- Clothing and/or Table Manners

Note: Consider ending with the Scripture study portion.

Day 5

Review what children have learned over the week by tossing the globe to various volunteers and asking them to state a fact about Senegal.

Use the Literacy Samples to show the children what their offerings will help to provide for children in Senegal. Discuss how these materials are similar to and different from the materials their teachers have used to help them learn to read.
