

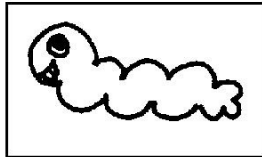
# May I Have a Snack, Mom?

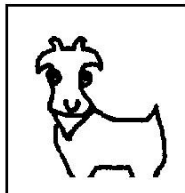

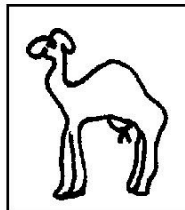

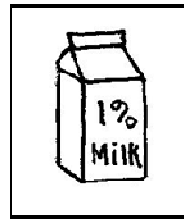
